#### WWJD?

A few years ago these four letters became very popular. It's kind of interesting that people came out of the woodwork wanting to identify with Jesus and were willing to ask the question, 'What would Jesus do?' But, they were not AT ALL interested in becoming a part of or in ANY WAY wanting to be associated with His followers - 'the church.'

People weren't flocking to 'church' during this craze, they were identifying with the compassion of Christ. If we, the church, were to ask ourselves that very same question I wonder what kind of answers we'd come up with? The question was usually applied to situational ethics like: stealing . . . WWJD? or fighting . . . WWJD? or watching a certain movie . . . WWJD? . . . relating to a moral behavior.

Temptation is not the only area to consider when applying this question. In fact, when we wake up in the morning we should be asking, "What would Jesus do today?" In an effort to take this seriously let's look at just a few things Jesus did.

Jesus . . .

- came to be a friend of sinners
- came to seek and to save the lost
- came not for those who are well, but for the sick
- came not for the righteous, but for the sinner
