Handling Conflict without Fighting Back or Running Away

I want to personally invite any man—18+ to join this eight week focus on resolving conflict with Biblical principles.

We experience conflict every day in a variety of ways. Sometimes we respond with grace and understanding, but sometimes we respond without a plan, without thinking, consumed by emotion and . . . well, sometimes we regret what's been said or done.

This focus takes a close look at what's called the Four G's. Here there are:

- **Glorify God** - Trust in the Lord and DO GOOD
- **Get the Log Out of Your Eye** - Conflict Starts in the Heart
- **Gently Restore** - Speak the Truth in Love
- **Go and Be Reconciled** - Forgive as God Forgave You

Peacemakers are people who breathe grace. They draw continually on the goodness and power of Jesus Christ, and then they bring his love, mercy, forgiveness, strength and wisdom to the conflicts of daily life.

This call is for the men of SHCC to lead in this peacemaking effort. Join us Monday evenings at 6:30pm as we pray for and cultivate spirit of God's peace.
