But, it caused me to be grateful for what I DID have (my life & family), and not focus so much on what didn't have (justice for a crazy teenage driver).

### **Corn Maze – October 18<sup>th</sup> 5:00 PM to 8:00 PM**

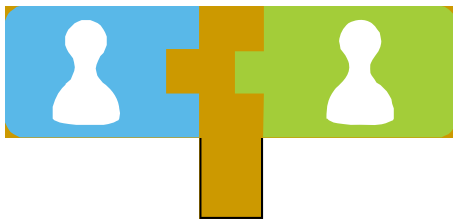

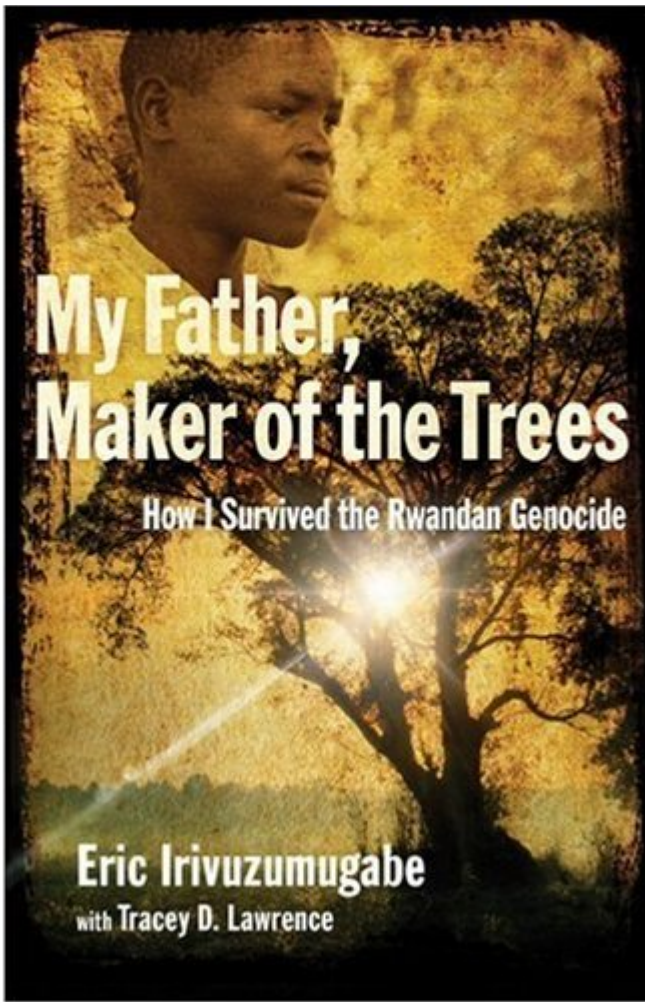
