

## LIFE GROUP STUDY GUIDE:

(60-minute session—02-13-22)

Welcome to the message series: *Building God's Way*. In this part of our series, we will be studying the New Testament Book of Acts, drawing out essential principles for our lives as Kingdom builders today.

Today's lesson comes from the last half of Acts 1 where we read about Matthias taking the place of Judas.

### Read Acts 1:12-26
