

# LIFE GROUP STUDY GUIDE:

(60-minute session—04-24-22)

Welcome to the message series: *Building God's Way*. In this part of our series, we will be studying the New Testament Book of Acts, drawing out essential principles for our lives as Kingdom builders today.

Today's lesson comes from Acts 4-5. In this lesson, and several that follow, we will look at the tactics used by Satan to derail the ministry efforts of the church, as well as, how we can and should navigate such pressures.
